Mr. O'Brien,

I am writing in response to your concerns with the venting materials on the Navien Combi Water Heaters.

There has been a printing error in our manual that states that the Navien requires stainless steel venting when installed in combination with circulation of return temperatures above 160F. This is correct with Navien CR/CC and NR/NP water heater models, but inaccurate with Navien CH Combi systems.

The Navien CH Combi systems have a built in safety that will modulate the burner to a lower fire which in turn reduces the temperature of the exhaust when sensing the temperatures to be too high. Therefore, the only vent materials required to vent the CH Combi systems are Schedule 40 solid core PVC.
